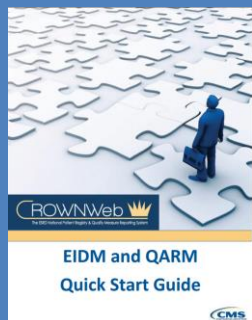

EQRS Goals

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), the ESRD Networks, and dialysis facilities continue to work on the End Stage Renal Disease Quality Reporting System (EQRS) goals which include reducing missing and saved CMS-2728 Forms in CROWNWeb, reducing the number of GAP patients, and verifying the Patient Attributes and Related Treatments (PART) – a monthly facility census verification. Although the initial start was slow with minimal results, we continue to strive to make anticipated improvements towards reaching the goals.

CROWNWeb 5.0 Training

QARM Role and Scope

Logging in to CROWNWeb 5.0

CROWNWeb 5.0 is up and running! An EIDM account with QARM access is required in order to access CROWNWeb 5.0. With this CROWNWeb release, users will access CROWNWeb 5.0 in a new location. Users will continue to login to CROWNWeb 5.0 via www.QualityNet.org, but will access it at a different location. Additional information on accessing CROWNWeb 5.0 is located in the **EIDM and QARM Quick Start Guide** found under the Education tab at www.mycrownweb.org.

*Note: If a user has access to more than one facility they may toggle between facilities by selecting the User Accessibility tab located in User Preferences.

2016 Clinical Data Closure Dates

CMS has announced that the May Clinical submission deadline has been extended to August 15, 2016. This extension was granted due to the transition to the Enterprise Identity Management (EIQM) and the Quality Authorization and Role Management (QARM) systems. This extension does not affect any future Month's Clinical Closure dates.

Clinical closure dates apply to all Collect Types. Additionally, clinical data submissions apply to all submission methods.
