## CROWNWeb 4.6 Released!

On December 19, 2014, CMS released the latest version of the CROWNWeb data collection system—CROWNWeb 4.6. In addition to visible enhancements in the system, this release features many unseen changes that will help improve the user experience, and introduces new ways of doing things in CROWNWeb.

### Show Me the Features: (Examples of implemented changes)

Feature	Description
<b>Attestation Verification</b>	During the Facility Attestation Reporting Period for Payment Year 2016 (January 1-31, 2015), users can make any necessary corrections to attestation submissions. Additionally, users will be able to review submitted attestations after the Reporting Period.
<b>Lab Entry from External Source</b>	In support of the ESRD QIP for Payment Year 2016, CROWNWeb now allows facilities to enter Serum Phosphorus; Uncorrected Serum Calcium; and Corrected Serum Calcium values obtain from an external source.
<b>Clinical Carry Over</b>	Vaccination, height and the unit of measure used, and vascular access data entered on the <i>Clinical</i> screens in CROWNWeb should carry over from month-to-month. (Still must be verified monthly)

## Completing Facility Attestations in CROWNWeb

Did you know that in January 2015, facility representatives must use CROWNWeb to attest if their facilities are not eligible for the ESRD QIP Reporting Measures for Payment Year 2016 because they did not treat a sufficient number of eligible patients? Users should closely review the [Final Measure Specifications for PY 2016](#) on CMS' website before logging in to CROWNWeb. Facilities that ARE eligible to be scored on a particular Reporting Measure should leave the Attestation fields for that measure in CROWNWeb blank.

## Double-Check Data Entries Before Submitting

In CROWNWeb, facility-level users cannot make changes to submitted CMS forms. Users must submit a ticket to the QualityNet Help Desk to request a change. **The TOP 5 reasons that facilities request CMS-2728 changes are:**



1. **Incorrect Social Security Number (SSN)**
2. **Incorrect Date Patient Started Chronic Dialysis at Current Facility**
3. **Incorrect Date of Birth**
4. **Incorrect First & Last Name**
5. **Incorrect Date Regular Chronic Dialysis Began**

Closely review information on the *Patient Attributes*, *Admit/Discharge* and *Form 2728* screens in CROWNWeb to help prevent the need for form modifications or deletions.

## CMS-2728/CMS-2746 Modification Tips

**Before submitting a service request to the QualityNet Help Desk to modify or delete a submitted CMS-2728 or CMS-2746 form, please do the following:**

1. Review and correct any patient attributes: e.g., SSN, HICNUM, Name, and Primary Cause of Renal failure. **Note: Never send PII and PHI.**
2. Review and correct applicable treatment data: e.g., treatment start dates, attending physician, etc.
3. Review and correct applicable lab dates: i.e., for 2728, lab dates must be within 45 days of Date Regular Chronic Dialysis Began.
4. Update local EMR or BSO system with any corrections applied to CROWNWeb.
