## CROWNWeb and ICD-10: What to Expect

On October 1, 2015, health care providers nation-wide will be required to use the tenth revision of the International Classification of Diseases (ICD) to indicate procedure and diagnosis codes. **CROWNWeb has been revised to assist facilities to comply with this federal requirement by allowing users to select the valid ICD-10-CM code for Primary Cause of Renal Failure on the CMS-2728 form.** What exactly should users expect when making ICD-10-CM selections in CROWNWeb?

- **CROWNWeb will continue to follow CMS' data entry and submission requirements – presenting errors and warnings as appropriate.**
- **The process to complete and submit the CMS-2728 form in CROWNWeb will remain the same.**
- **Users will have access to a list of recommended ICD-10-CM codes for the CMS-2728 form.**
- **CROWNWeb will present the appropriate code selections based on the patient's admission date.**

## ICD-9-CM Codes or ICD-10-CM Codes? That is the Question!

When a user completes a CMS-2728 form in CROWNWeb, the system is programmed to review the patient's admit date to determine if an ICD-9-CM or ICD-10-CM code is required for Field 15 – Primary Cause of Renal Failure. CROWNWeb uses the following logic:

Patients admitted **BEFORE** October 1, 2015

- Users will be presented with ICD-9-CM codes
- Users can only select and submit ICD-9-CM codes on the CMS-2728 form


Patients admitted **ON or AFTER** October 1, 2015

- Users will be presented with ICD-10-CM codes
- Users can only select and submit approved ICD-10-CM codes on the CMS-2728 form

## ICD-10-CM Selections in CROWNWeb

Since its initial release, CROWNWeb has presented users with 3 methods of indicating a patient's Primary Cause of Renal Failure on the CMS-2728 form. With the implementation of the ICD-10-CM codes, CROWNWeb continues to follow this format by allowing users to:

1. **Manually enter code** –
  - CROWNWeb Single User Interface – Users can manually type an ICD-10-CM code in field 15, as long as it matches an allowable Primary Cause of Renal Failure code
  - CROWNWeb Electronic Data Interchange – EDI Submitters can submit an ICD-10-CM code via XML Batch or via the NRAA-HIE Nationwide Health Information Network (NwHIN)
2. **Use code drop-down list** – CROWNWeb presents users with a drop-down list that includes applicable ICD-10-CM codes
3. **Use “Lookup Diagnosis Codes” list** – CROWNWeb presents a link to a static page that lists all the allowable ICD-10-CM codes

## Valid ICD-10-CM Code Entries in CROWNWeb

To help guide data entry efforts, CMS provides CROWNWeb users with a Code List that includes 110 recommended ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes for Primary Cause of Renal Failure. The system is designed to only accept entries from the Code List at the start of the ICD-10-CM implementation. However, the Code List will be reviewed and updated as needed to help ensure that the valid diagnosis codes for Primary Causes of Renal Failure are available. CMS recommends using the ICD-10 Code Book/Manual to select the appropriate code for the Primary Cause of Renal Failure, available via <https://www.cms.gov/Medicare/Coding/ICD10/2016-ICD-10-CM-and-GEMs.html>.

Users should contact the QualityNet Help Desk to generate a ticket if an ICD-10-CM code noted on the CMS-2728 form is not accepted in CROWNWeb. In a future release, CROWNWeb will be re-programmed to accept any valid ICD-10-CM code so the Code List will become a reference tool only.
