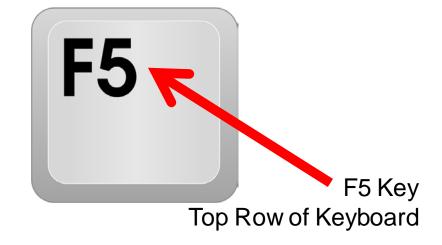

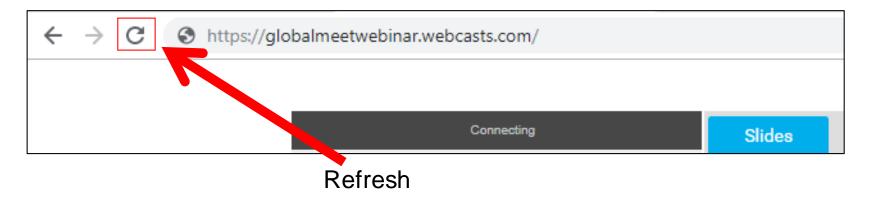

Troubleshooting Audio

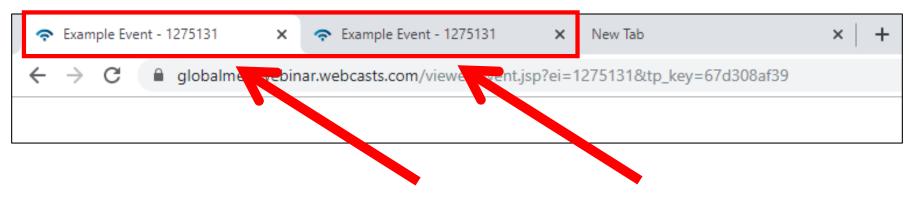
Audio from computer speakers breaking up? Audio suddenly stop? Click Refresh – or – Press F5





Troubleshooting Echo

- Hear a bad echo on the call?
- Echo is caused by multiple browsers/tabs open to a single event (multiple audio feeds).
- Close all but one browser/tab and the echo will clear.

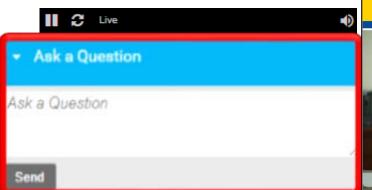


Example of Two Browsers/Tabs Open in Same Event

EQRS Announcement



EQRS Challenges

- The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is aware
 of the challenges that some users may be facing with submitting
 data via the End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) Quality
 Reporting System.
- CMS is committed to ensuring the accuracy and reliability of its data.
- CMS is working to rapidly resolve these issues.
- CMS will continue to monitor and assess its systems for any issues on an ongoing basis as a part of continuous process improvement and to ensure a positive user experience.

EQRS Data Suspension

- Effective January 29, 2021, CMS suspended EQRS Clinical Data, In-Center Hemodialysis Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems (ICH CAHPS) Attestation, and Clinical Depression Screening and Follow-Up Plan submission.
- Users should not send any additional clinical data to CMS while it works towards implementing solutions that can support data reporting requirements and the EQRS user community's needs.

Current Clinical Closure Suspensions

September 2020 Clinical Month	Suspended until further notice.
October 2020 Clinical Month	Suspended until further notice.
November 2020 Clinical Month	Suspended until further notice.
December 2020 Clinical Month	Suspended until further notice.

Facility Dashboard and Clinical Screen

- Submission deadlines on the Facility Dashboard, Clinical, ICH CAHPS Facility Attestation, and Clinical Depression Screening and Follow-Up Plan screens will be updated, as needed.
- Impacted Clinical Months may continue to transition from "Open" to "Closed" on the Clinical screen, but will be re-opened to allow data reporting, once data submission resumes.
- Facilities must continue to gather and maintain patients' clinical data and plan to provide all necessary data, once data reporting resumes.
- CMS will provide updated information on submission requirements and deadlines.

Current EQRS Data Reporting Requirements



Current Requirements

 Please note that this temporary suspension applies to Clinical Data, ICH CAHPS Attestation, and Clinical Depression
 Screening and Follow-Up Plan submissions ONLY.

EQRS users must continue to use the system to complete tasks such as:

- Admit and discharge patients
- Complete CMS forms
- Add and update details on the Treatments screen
- Resolve accretions
- Update facility details

ESRD Systems Data Management Guidelines

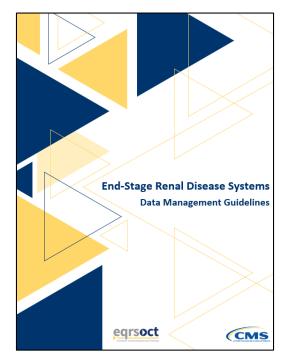
 Users must continue to follow the ESRD Systems Data Management Guidelines for current EQRS data submissions.

This document describes standardized data management processes

created, reviewed, and approved by CMS.

 Tasks to be completed by system users and submission timelines are identified in this ESRD Systems Data Management Guidelines document.

- These tasks fall into three categories:
 - Data Monitoring
 - Data Quality Measuring
 - Data Quality Managing

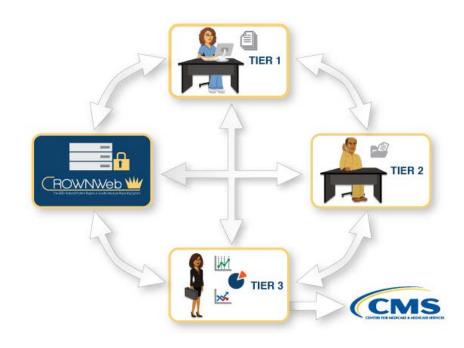


ESRD Systems Data Manager

A Data Manager is defined as any authorized user who oversees or assists with promoting data quality by *monitoring*, contributing to data effectiveness by *measuring*, and ensuring data reliability by *managing* accurate and timely data submissions.

There are three tiers of Data Managers:

- **Tier 1** Individuals or groups that enter patient and facility details into the ESRD Systems.
- Tier 2 Individuals or groups that provide technical data reporting assistance.
- Tier 3 Individuals or groups that support CMS data reporting needs.

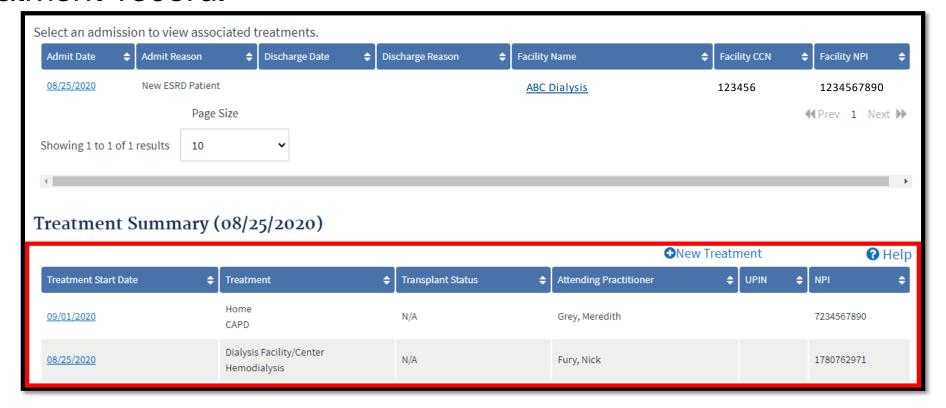


CMS-2744 in EQRS

- CMS-2744 Annual Facility Surveys are completed by dialysis facilities and transplant centers.
- Follow your ESRD Network's guidance and local submission deadline to Finalize CMS-2744 forms in EQRS.
- EQRS pulls data from the following screens to pre-populate CMS-2744 fields:
 - Facility Details
 - Patient (Demographics)
 - Admissions
 - Treatments

CMS-2744 Troubleshooting: Add Treatment

 Add a new treatment record when there is a new doctorprescribed change in a patient's treatment. Do not edit the existing treatment record.



CMS-2744 Troubleshooting: Discharge Reason

 Update a "System Discharge" to reflect a patient's correct discharge reason.

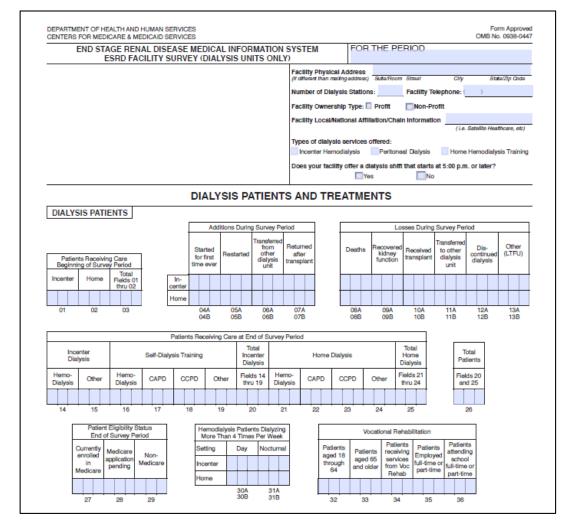


CMS-2744 Troubleshooting: Use Reports

 Use the Patient Roster and Patient Events reports to assist with getting an overview of current patients and reported events.



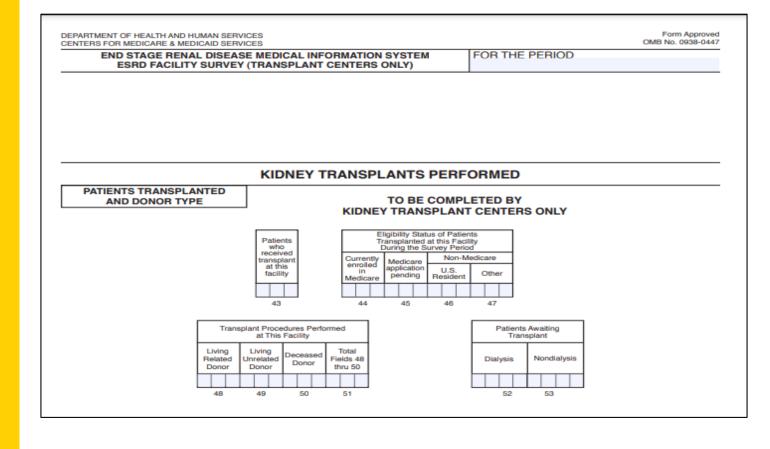

EQRS FAQs



FAQ: Account Management

Can you assist me with unlocking my account?

- To avoid being locked out, users must log in to their Healthcare Quality Information System (HCQIS) Access Roles and Profile (HARP) and/or EQRS regularly.
- Users must update passwords via HARP, as needed.
- Users can recover their account and reset passwords by using HARP's self-service options:

FAQ: Field 24 on a CMS-2728 Form

Field 24: Date Patient Started Chronic Dialysis at Current Facility is incorrect. Can you assist me with updating this field?

- The CMS-2728 form pre-populate fields based on data entered on the Patient, Admissions, and Treatments screens.
- Field 24 is using the date entered in EQRS as the patient's admission date.
- Go to the Admissions screen and make the necessary updates.
- Field 24 will be updated on the CMS-2728 form in EQRS, if the form is still in a Saved status.

NOTE: Please work with your corporate office or vendor to correct the admission date if your facility's data is electronically entered into EQRS.

FAQ: Printing a CMS-2728 Form

I am having issues printing a CMS-2728 form. Can you assist me with printing this form?

- Remember to use Google Chrome to access EQRS.
- Clear cache and cookies. (Quick instructions: Open your Google Chrome, click Ctrl + Shift + Delete, check the cookies and cache options, and click "Clear data.")
- Look at the Existing 2728 Forms section in EQRS.
 - If the "Form Version" is 2014 or earlier, it won't print. You will need to work with the original facility or your ESRD Network to print the form.

FAQ: Adding a CMS-2746 Form

I do not see the option to complete a CMS-2746 form. Can you assist me with completing this form in EQRS?

- Remember to use Google Chrome to access EQRS.
- You need to enter the date and cause of death on the Patient screen.
- Click the Form 2746 link on the left-hand side of the screen.

FAQ: CMS Forms

I noticed an error on a Submitted CMS-2728 form. How can I fix this?

- Please closely review all entries for accuracy prior to submitting in EQRS.
- Data can be corrected on the CMS-2728 and CMS-2746 forms at the facility-level, if the forms are still in a "Saved" status.
- Contact the QualityNet Service Desk to review the record and determine if a correction can be applied. https://qualitynet.cms.gov/support

NOTE: Please work with your corporate office or vendor to correct data in your internal system, if needed.

FAQ: Admit and Discharge

When attempting to admit a patient to my facility, I received a possible duplicate patient error. Can you assist me with admitting this patient?

- EQRS uses six key identifiers when transferring a patient, to determine if the patient is already in the system:
 - First Name
 - Last Name
 - Date of Birth
 - Gender
 - Social Security Number
 - Medicare Beneficiary Identifier
- Closely review your data for accuracy.
- Contact your ESRD Network to review the record, if needed.
